Trans Active

Trans Active aims to help the trans community in and around Sheffield socialise and improve their fitness and mental wellbeing through sport in a safe, relaxed environment. Our activities are open to all trans/non-binary and gender questioning people.

We run trans only swimming sessions are held every other Saturday at Heeley Pool from 1.30–2.30pm. Each session costs £1.50 to attend and you can wear whatever you feel comfortable in as long as it's suitable for swimming. We have private use of the pool area and there are individual changing cubicles as well as male and female communal facilities. The lifeguards have also been trained to be sensitive to trans people's needs.

We also organise one-off sessions to allow people to try out other activities, such as badminton, tennis, football, canoeing, sailing and climbing. These activities are usually open to cis partners, friends and family members too. There will usually be a small cost to attend, generally £1.50 but sometimes a bit more for more expensive activities such as climbing.
